



Pre-Surgical Instructions

- No food should be offered to patient (NPO) after 6:30 pm the night before surgery. Water is completely fine just please do not allow a lot right before your pet comes in.
 - Do NOT feed your pet the morning of surgery!
- Please drop your pet off between 7:00 - 7:30am the morning of their procedure.
 - Please walk your pet before dropping off!
- If your pet is having ANY surgical procedure please keep your phone on you at all times as a doctor may have to contact you while your pet is under anesthesia.
- Please give your pet Pepcid AC (Famotidine)
_____ mg in the evening starting 3 days the scheduled procedure.
- Females: if a female is in heat or pregnant during a spay surgery, there will be an additional charge.
 - Ask your technician or receptionist for cost.
- We highly recommend a hard e-collar with all procedures that involve sutures.
- Once your pet's procedure is complete, you will receive a call from your pet's doctor or a technician to let you know when your pet is ready for pick-up. All pets are to be picked up before 5:00pm!
- We are closed on Wednesdays and some Saturdays. If your pet has a procedure on Tuesday or Friday's and you have concerns or an emergency please contact: UF Small Animal Hospital(352-392-2235), Community Care Veterinary Specialists(352-225-3501) , or Urgent Vet(352-374-0040).
- We are a flea and tick free facility! If a pet is found with live fleas or ticks the pet will get an oral flea and tick pill at the owner's expense.
